## **JPMorgan Chase Pledges Financial Assistance to the Philippines Relief Effort**

### **Firm to donate \$1 million and match employee contributions up to \$250,000**

**New York, November 13, 2013** - JPMorgan Chase announced today that it is pledging \$1 million to relief efforts taking place in the Philippines, following the devastation caused by Typhoon Haiyan. The donation will help provide food, supplies and home-repair kits for 80,000 families in the provinces of Samar, Leyte and Cebu.
